NSERC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

(Natural Science and Engineering Research Council)

Value: \$17,500 to \$35,000 per year
Duration: 1-3 years
Eligibility: A degree in science or engineering
Deadline: **September 29, 2017**

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Currently registered full or part-time at, or on an approved leave of absence from our university, **or** not registered and have completed all requirements for a degree from your university in 2016;
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada as of November 25, 2017;
- Have a minimum first-class average (**10.0/12 GPA**) in each of the last two completed years of study (full-time equivalent - 2 years of part-time study equals 1 year of full-time study). GPAs are not rounded up (9.9 does not equal 10.0);
- Completed, as of December 31 of the year of application, between **zero and 24 months** of studies (full-time equivalent) in the doctoral program for which you are requesting funding; or if admitted into a doctoral program directly from your bachelor's program (you were never registered in a master's program), you must have completed, as of December 31 of the year of application, between **four and 36 months** of studies (full-time equivalent) in the doctoral program for which you are requesting funding;
- Must not hold, or have held, a scholarship or fellowship from SSHRC, NSERC or CIHR to undertake or complete a doctoral program;
- **ORIGINAL** transcripts of all post-secondary work are required.
